Bond Fees

Customers are responsible for payment of duties and taxes. When funds are not provided in advance by the customer, and UPS® must post a bond to allow UPS shipments to be released in advance of payment to the Canada

Border Services Agency (CBSA), a fee of 2.7% (minimum \$6 on UPS Standard; minimum \$10 on UPS Worldwide Express Plus, UPS Worldwide Express, UPS Worldwide Express Freight, UPS Worldwide Express Saver and UPS Worldwide Expedited) of the

amount advanced by UPS will be charged. To avoid bond fees, call 1-800-PICK-UPS and ask about our Prepayment or Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) plans.

- **** This fee may apply when the included documents are missing critical information and a telephone call or other form of communication is required to obtain the correct information. Examples of missing information include poor descriptions, no country of origin, missing quantities, etc.
- † Free When brokerage service for your imports is provided by UPS or its designate, there is no Entry Preparation Fee for routine customs clearance of UPS Worldwide Express Plus, UPS Worldwide Express, UPS Worldwide Express Freight, UPS Worldwide Express Saver and UPS Worldwide Expedited shipments, including up to five classification lines. Charges may apply for more complex customs clearance procedures.
